Maths

During our Maths learning we will be looking at Numbers and the Number System.

Starting with counting in ones, tens and hundreds, forwards and backwards, beginning with any given number.

Also, we will be learning how to recognise the place value of each numeral in at least 2 digit numbers (tens and ones).

Writing

This half we are writing Non-Chronological Reports. Our focus will be writing coherent sentences ensuring our writing contains the correct punctuation (capital letters and full stops) as well as incorporating lots of adjectives to describe and make our writing more exciting to read.

Home Learning

Each Friday we will be sending out home learning. This will reinforce the skills which have been taught in school and will give children the opportunity to practice what they have learnt throughout the week. We also ask that children read at home everyday and that their reading record is signed.

Topic

Throughout this half term will be covering lots of exciting areas within our Topic sessions.

In ICT we will be learning all about online safety and how we can stay safe whilst using the internet and our devices.

In science, we will be covering Biology and discussing 'Healthy Humans'. Children will discover and learn the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival as well identifying, drawing, and labelling the basic parts of the human body.

Our PSHCE topic is 'Being Me in My World' where we will be studying our rights and responsibilities as well as rewards and consequences. Alongside this, in RE we are learning all about how people face moral choices developing our learning on belonging, understanding the world, people and communities.

During Art, we will be exploring observational drawing, exploring proportion, tone and line whilst looking at the work of the artist Adonna Khare.

Finally, in History, we will be investigating our local area, diving into the history of Leeds. We will develop our chronological understanding and explore changes and similarities between the past and present.
