What am I learning this half term?

Spring is in the air! We have a brilliant topic to kick start this half term with an excellent learning opportunity to inspire and motivate. It is all linked around Bugs life! Children will be able to write a simple structed sentence with support and will be able to form most of the letters of their name correctly. Their drawing will have increased in accuracy and will be able to use scissors to cut multiple shapes. Children will have established secure positive relationships with the adult members of the class as well as their peers. In maths they will be able to find one less than a number given to 20. Term target is to be able to understand subtraction what this means and how we subtract using practical objects. Our children will begin to recognise and name a variety of different plants, not only the ones that they grow but native plants that may, as weeds, need to be removed from their garden. They will also begin to confidently talk about what a plant needs to thrive, including light, water, and soil. They will know what makes themselves healthy (food, sleep, exercise). Children will be able to print with a range of different materials and create with a purpose in mind. Also, will be able to evaluate what they have done and what they would do next time.
