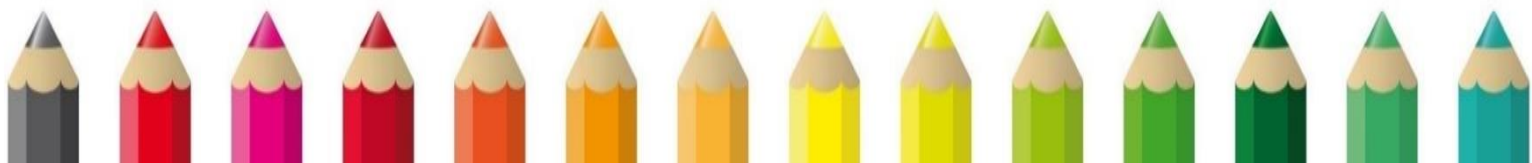

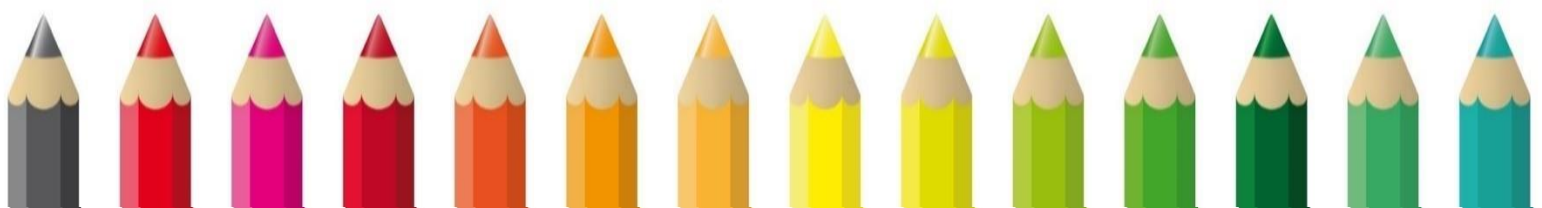
### Walking on Sunshine, Whoa!

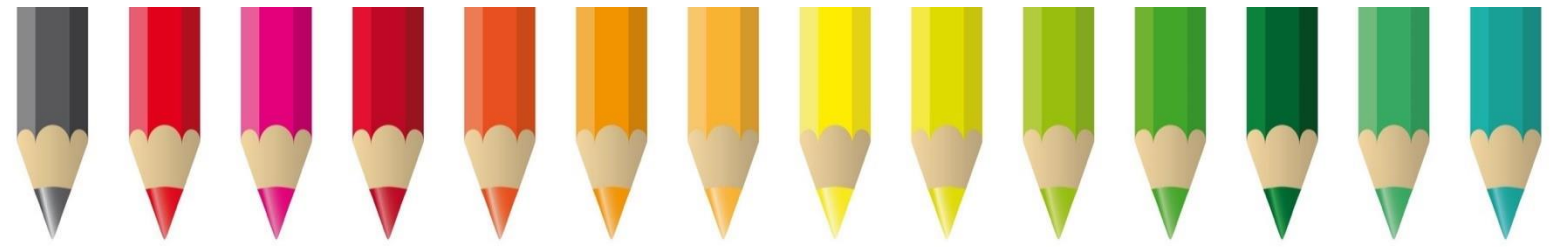

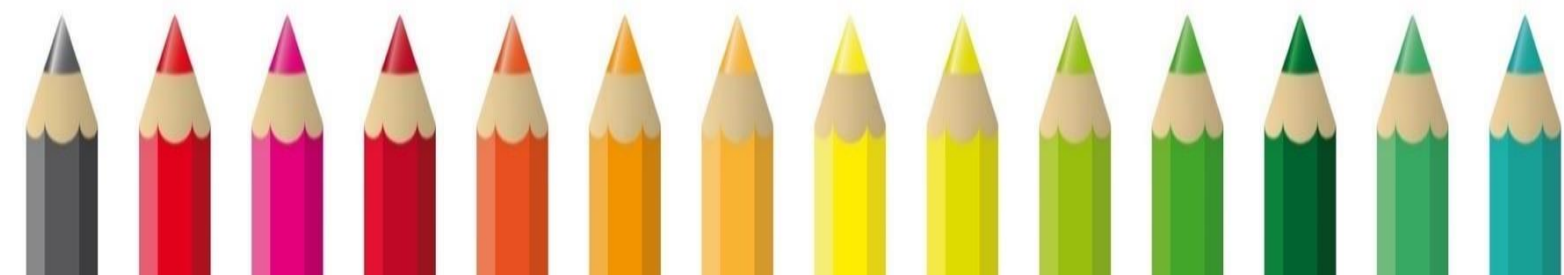
## Nursery Workshop

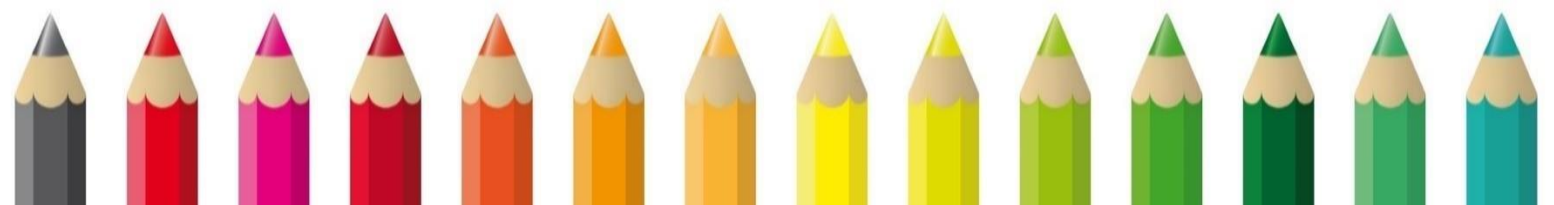
