



A note from the Teachers

Welcome to Autumn term 2! This term in Nursery we will be discussing celebrations in different festivals, customs, and traditions from around the world to foster an understanding of diversity and respect. This will be done through engaging activities like role-playing, sharing stories, creative arts and crafts, and inviting family members to share their experiences. The focus is on helping children appreciate differences, recognize commonalities, and develop their communication and social skills by talking about celebrations like Diwali and birthdays!

### **Subject News**



In literacy, we are encouraging children to talk about key events and characters in stories. We are discussing the events in stories and suggest how the story might end.



This half term, we are drawing simple representations of a person using circles ,horizontal & vertical lines and exploring zig zags.



We are focusing on developing independence in relation to children's own care needs for example taking their own shoes off or putting them on.



In maths, we are focusing on saying one number for each item in order: 1,2,3,4,5. We are also modelling 1:1 counting.



We are introducing new vocabulary linked to different Celebrations.



Our learning will be linked to talking about children's life and family's history. We will be looking at special events e.g birthdays!



This half term, our PSHE is all about celebrating differences. We will also be discussing about feelings.

### **Subject News**



This half term children will demonstrate a growing understanding of what has been read to them by retelling stories whilst using their own words.



To prepare for future handwriting, we're concentrating on key fine motor skills this half term. This includes practicing scissor skills, learning to accurately cut shapes and mastering the essential Tripod Grip when holding pencils.



We're encouraging children to take charge of their clothing choices! This term, we'll be focusing on helping them become independent with dressing up and learning how to adjust their clothes for changing weather. Please continue to support this vital skill at home!



Children will be developing a strong understanding of odd and even numbers. We'll make this concept visual and engaging, using practical resources such as Numicon and 10-frames



We're focusing on teaching children essential social phrases. We are also helping them connect their thoughts and actions logically by using a wider range of connectives (such as because, so, then, and but).



This half term, our Science topic is Light Magic! We will explore how light works, focusing on fun phenomena like reflections, shadows and colours. The children will love investigating and making predictions in this hands-on unit.




We are focusing on promoting selfesteem and diversity this term! Children will participate in activities that encourage them to identify "What I Am Good At," helping them feel confident and valued. Crucially. they will also be learning to understand and accept that everyone is different!

### **Home Learning**

Each week your child will recieve two pieces of home learning: one phonics sheet - which will link to the learning will have been doing in class. There will also be a maths based learning sheet which will link to the week's learning. 
### **Subject News**



In our guided reading sessions we will be using the Rocket Phonics books which are targeted to help improve fluency. We also ask that children read at home everyday and that their reading record is signed.



This half term, our children will be stepping into the role of event planners as we focus on the art of writing invitations!





This half term, we're making Maths practical and relevant! We will be building confidence in Addition and Subtraction through engaging activities. Crucially, we will be linking these skills to real-life problems, with a special focus on money.



This half term, our creative 'Media' focus is on designing and creating cards! Children will explore different materials and techniques to make their own unique cards. This project encourages artistic expression, fine motor skills, and an understanding of purpose-driven design — thinking about who the card is for and why.



Our creative project this term is all about Moving Cards! This is a fantastic introduction to basic mechanisms and engineering. Children will be challenged to design and build a card that includes a moving element, such as a lever, slider, or pivot.



This half term in PSHE, is about teaching children to recognise, respect, and celebrate what makes people unique while also understanding the common bonds that connect everyone

### **Home Learning**

Each week your child will receive various pieces of home learning:



Also involved in this half term, are some exciting events such as Anti-Bullying week, Children in Need, our first assessments of this academic year and finally... all things Christmas . This includes visits to the Pantomime, Christmas parties and dinner and jumper day.

### **Subject News**



This half term we will be exploring the novel Mr Gum, a grumpy old man who hates children, animals and all things fun. Through this novel children will develop comprehension and fluency skills.



This half term we will be writing non-chronological reports, focusing on developing simple and complex sentences, using paragraphs and other devices to improve fluidity of our writing.



This half term we will focus our learning to addition and subtractions looking in more details at the formal methods and linking this to real life problems, including money!



This half term we are exploring the different states of matter! Looking at the difference between solids, liquids and gases. The reason why these states exist and finish with our very own scientific experiment.



Our topic this half term is Volcanoes and Earthquakes. We will understand how these natural disasters occur, use mapping skills to locate these events and ask the question why do people live in these areas?



Our topic this half term is mechanical systems, we will look at how toys/books make objects move. We will work through planning, designing and creating phases. I'm looking forward to the end products!

### **Subject News**



This half term, Years 5 and 6 will be reading the novel, 'Wonder'. This book will help the children to develop their understanding of the protected characteristics we have and continue to learn about in PSHE.



In writing, we begin the term with a SPAG week where the children will learn how to include and create different types of sentences. Following this, we will practise writing non-chronological reports and short stories.



In maths this half term, the children will consolidate their understanding of number and the number system alongside the four operations (+, -, x and ÷)



In Science, the children will be learning about materials and their properties. They will scientifically uncover the reasons why certain materials are used in our day-to-day lives.



UKS2 will be learning all about settlements and trade. The children will look at the different types of settlements and use this knowledege to create their own. To finish this off, the children will learn about trade and how this happens on a global scale.



This half term in PSHE the focus is 'Celebrating Differences. The children will be looking at what makes us unique from each other and how this should be celebrated across the whole world.

In writing, we are looking at Explanations and instructions and using simple sentences to create our own.
