- We will develop children's social responsibility through hands on and active participation in community based projects and volunteering.

Nurturing Childhood Experiences

We believe children should leave primary school with memories, skills, and knowledge that stretch far beyond the classroom walls.

- We will commit to all children participating in 100 experiences before they leave primary school to develop their cultural capital.
- We will foster a culture of resilience and perseverance by encouraging children to view mistakes as learning opportunities and developing the determination needed to succeed when tasks are challenging.

Understanding Life in the Wider World

We believe that the world is the ultimate classroom, offering lessons that no book can contain. Our commitment is to enable children to experience the wider world firsthand.

- We will enable children to experience the wider world through trips, including residentials.
- We will enable children to experience a range of environments, including urban settings, natural landscapes (e.g., coasts, forests), and places of work, to expand their frame of reference and understanding of different sectors and lifestyles.
- We will seek to facilitate opportunities for children to meet and interact with professionals and experts in various fields outside of the school setting, inspiring career aspirations and showcasing the relevance of their classroom learning to the real world.



Curriculum for the Future

- We will consistently implement co-planning, observation cycles and enquiry sessions across all teaching teams, ensuring high quality practice is translated effectively into daily classroom practice in every school.
- We will actively participate in Trust-level peer review cycles, enquiry opportunities and professional networks to systematically refine and align inclusion provision across our schools.
- We will collaborate with external professionals through joint Continuing Professional Development (CPD) sessions, leveraging their expertise to ensure the highest level of support for our children.
