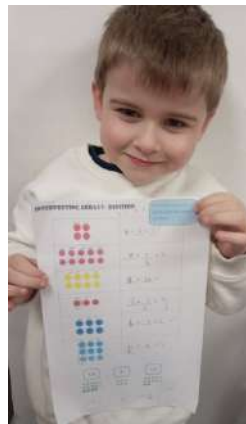

## PUNCTUALITY:



Arriving just 10 minutes late every day results in 32 hours of lost learning over the school year.

## Stronger Friendships

## The 90% Rule:

### Stay Organised:

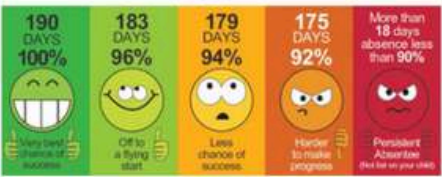
Help them pack an organised backpack so they are prepared for class.
